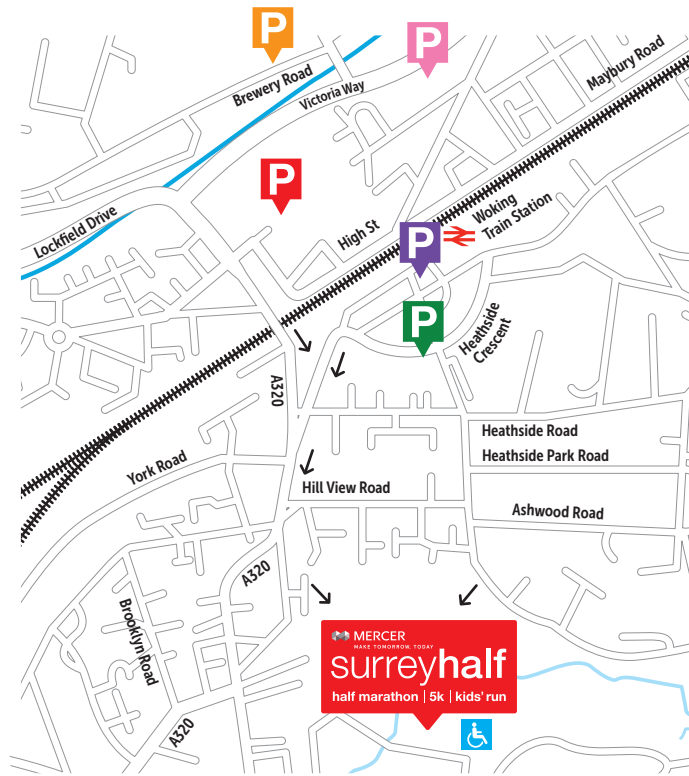

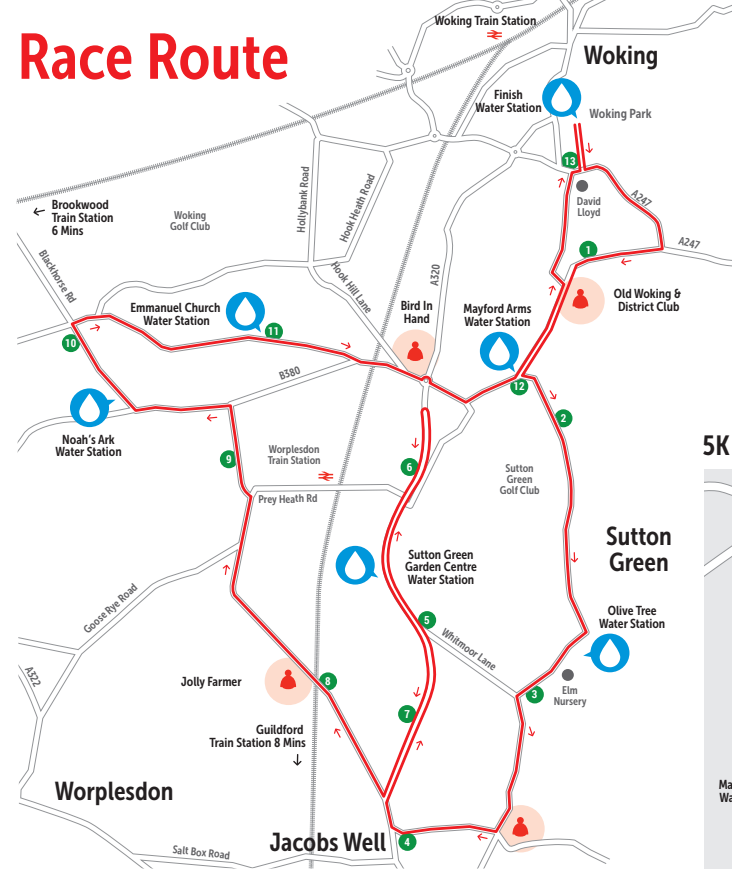

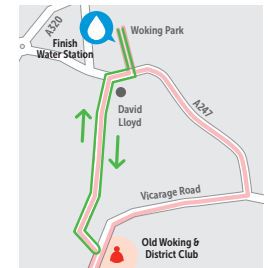
Race Route



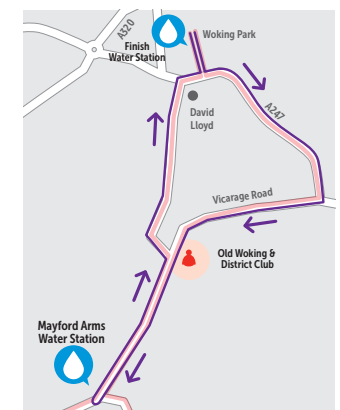

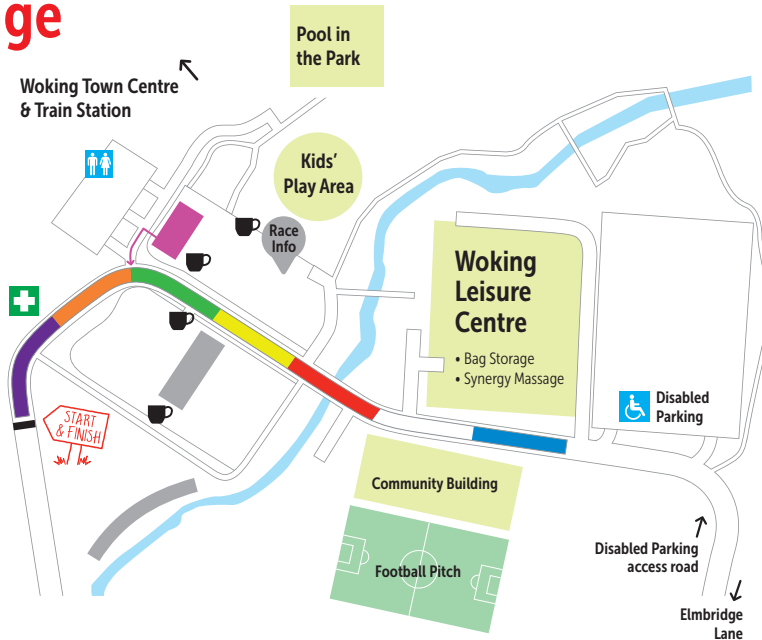

Race Day Guide Information

RACE TIMES

- 07:00 Event Village opens
- 07:00 Race Pens open
- 08:00 5km Event starts
- 08:45 5km Event finishes
- 09:00 Mercer Surrey Half Marathon starts
- 09:20 Kids' Run starts
- 10:00 Mercer Surrey Half Marathon winner finishes
- 11:30 Prize presentation (podium)
- 12:15 Mercer Surrey Half Marathon finishes.
The route closes in sections.

RACE PACKS

Race Packs can be collected in person from the Mercer Surrey Half Expo 10:00-13:00 at Woking Leisure Centre on 11th February. UK residents who do not attend the expo will receive their Race Pack by post. International runners should collect their pack from the Information Tent on race morning.

NUMBER AND CHIP










Each Race Pack includes a race number. Your timing chip is embedded within this number. Please bring your race number with you on 12th March 2017 having completed the emergency contact details form on the back. The race number should be pinned to your front. Never swap race number with another runner. Anyone who run under a false name will be disqualified. Gun and chip times will be automatically recorded for all participants.

STARTING PENS

Please arrive in good time to make your way to the start pens. These are identified by flags indicating different predicted finish times. You may move back through pens to join friends, but moving ahead is forbidden.

RACE PACERS

Xempo race pacers will lead each start pen out onto the course and complete the race with you.

TRAVEL

There is no parking available at the Leisure Centre, so please walk, cycle, or get public transport to the Mercer Surrey Half Marathon if possible.

Trains – Woking train station is a 10-minute walk from Woking Leisure Centre.

Buses – Please check your local timetable.

Parking – Only disabled parking is available at the Woking Leisure Centre. Car parking is available in Woking Town Centre. (See map)

KIDS' RUN

The Kids' Run, organised by Advanced Sport, will begin promptly at 09:20. Your child should be at the Kids' Hub at 09:10 for their warm up. The baggage tag on their bib number is your collection receipt. The parent or guardian responsible for collecting their child after their race must produce this baggage tag – which matches their child's race number. This must be shown to a marshal at the Kids' Hub to collect your child.

5KM EVENT

The 5km event will begin at 08:00. Please make sure you're at the start line by 07:45 with your race number pinned to the front of your top. The closed-road 5km course starts and finishes under the main event gantry. After 08:45 any 5km runners remaining on the course will be asked to move onto the pavements to make way for the Mercer Surrey Half Marathon start.

UKA AFFILIATION

The Mercer Surrey Half Marathon is delivered to the highest standard, and UKA affiliated. Your finish time will qualify for listing on the Power of 10 website.

BAG STORAGE

Please attach the baggage label included within your Race Pack to the bag you wish to store before you arrive at Bag Storage located in the Leisure Centre. The race organisers cannot be held responsible for your possessions. We advise you to leave valuable items at home.

INFORMATION TENT

If you have any queries or problems on race morning, please go to the Information Tent and the marshals there will assist you. Lost property will be located in the Information Tent.

CATERING

The Event Village will include several catering options. Cooked breakfast, crepes and Cafe2U coffee vans are onsite.

HEADPHONES

You are very strongly advised against running with headphones. You won't be able to hear the emergency services attending a critically ill runner or a marshal instructing you. You will need to hear public announcements and emergency vehicles on the course. Running without headphones will enable you to appreciate the race atmosphere and support you'll get from spectators and other runners. You will also be able to listen to our great bands along the route.

Please do not run with headphones.

LITTER

Please use the waste facilities provided at the Event Village and on the run route. Runners who litter will be automatically disqualified.

MEDICAL SUPPORT

If at any time you feel unable to continue the race, please speak to your nearest marshal. Medical staff will be on hand to support athletes.

WATER STATIONS

There are four stations on the Mercer Surrey Half Marathon route where you can collect a water bottle: at mile 3, 5, 9, 11 and 12. Water is supplied in 250ml sports cap bottles (See map). Kids' Run, 5km and Half Marathon participants will receive a water bottle on the finish line.

TOILETS

There will be numerous toilets available within the Event Village (see map).

PRIZE PRESENTATION

Athletes eligible for the prize presentation will be informed of this as they cross the finish line. The prize presentation ceremony will take place on the podium at 11:30am. Winners should make their way to the podium to receive their prize.

ROAD CLOSURES

Roads will be opened as soon as it is safe to do so. Runners still on the course after 12:15 will be asked to move onto the pavements from the 10-mile marker.

VEHICLES ON ROUTE

Emergency crew, care workers, and event crew will be travelling the run route in their vehicles. Please remain alert and expect to have to stop for these key workers.
